In this simulation, kids 8-12 make spending decisions and deal with setbacks—all while running a virtual lemonade stand.

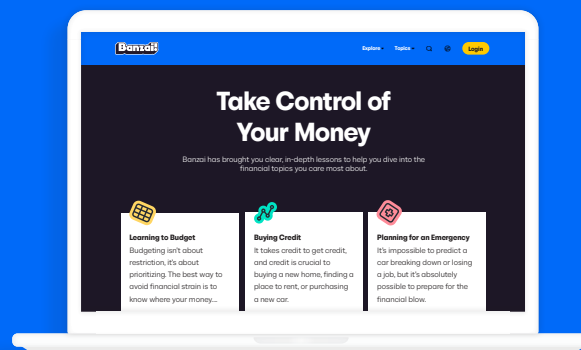
